Stranger Ranger Classes

Two classes offered Mondays at Ethel Eyerly Senior Center:

6pm–7pm for ages 5-8; and 7pm–8pm for ages 9 & older.

This is an anti-kidnapping and child defense program that is made from proven life saving techniques and different martial arts moves that are safe and effective for children. The "Stranger Ranger" curriculum teaches children how to avoid abduction, how to get away, and how to get help. This program is designed to help children at times when danger is near and to teach them the good values, build self-confidence, respect, honor, and discipline. This is an on-going program set-up on a martial arts belt advancing system. The curriculum also includes games, role playing, tests, and fun competitions. Professional instruction is provided by the Primetime-Kidsafe Company. Cost is \$28 per month and an additional seasonal registration fees.

Classes start August 30, 2010. Registration will be ongoing.

Guitar Classes
